## **Documentary Film Production Services**

The National Information and Communications Technology Authority (NICTA) is an independent regulatory authority established under the *National Information and Communications Technology Act* 2009. NICTA is responsible for regulating the ICT sector in Papua New Guinea (PNG), covering telecommunications, radiocommunications, and broadcasting.

NICTA is inviting proposals from experienced film production companies to produce a high-quality documentary film as part of Papua New Guinea's 50<sup>th</sup> Independence Anniversary celebrations.

### **About the Project**

NICTA holds the exclusive worldwide film rights to two books by the late James Sinclair:

- 1. Uniting a Nation: The Postal and Telecommunication Services of Papua New Guinea (1984); and
- 2. PTC: Uniting a Nation Through the 1980s (1993).

These books chronicle the history and impact of telecommunications in PNG. This documentary film will bring their stories to life, meeting broadcast, streaming, and cinema standards. The film will serve as both an educational and archival resource for future generations.

## Who Can Apply?

Proposals are welcome from qualified PNG and international film production companies, including PNG-based producers who have partnered with international co-producers.

#### **Evaluation Criteria**

While cost is a factor, the focus is on quality and value. Proposals will be assessed based on the following criteria:

- Expertise in historical/documentary filmmaking;
- Access to top-tier production resources, talent, and technical capabilities;
- Experience working in the Pacific or on culturally significant projects; and
- Preferably, prior experience in the telecommunications and ICT sectors.

The completed film must be delivered on or before Sunday, 31 August 2025.
